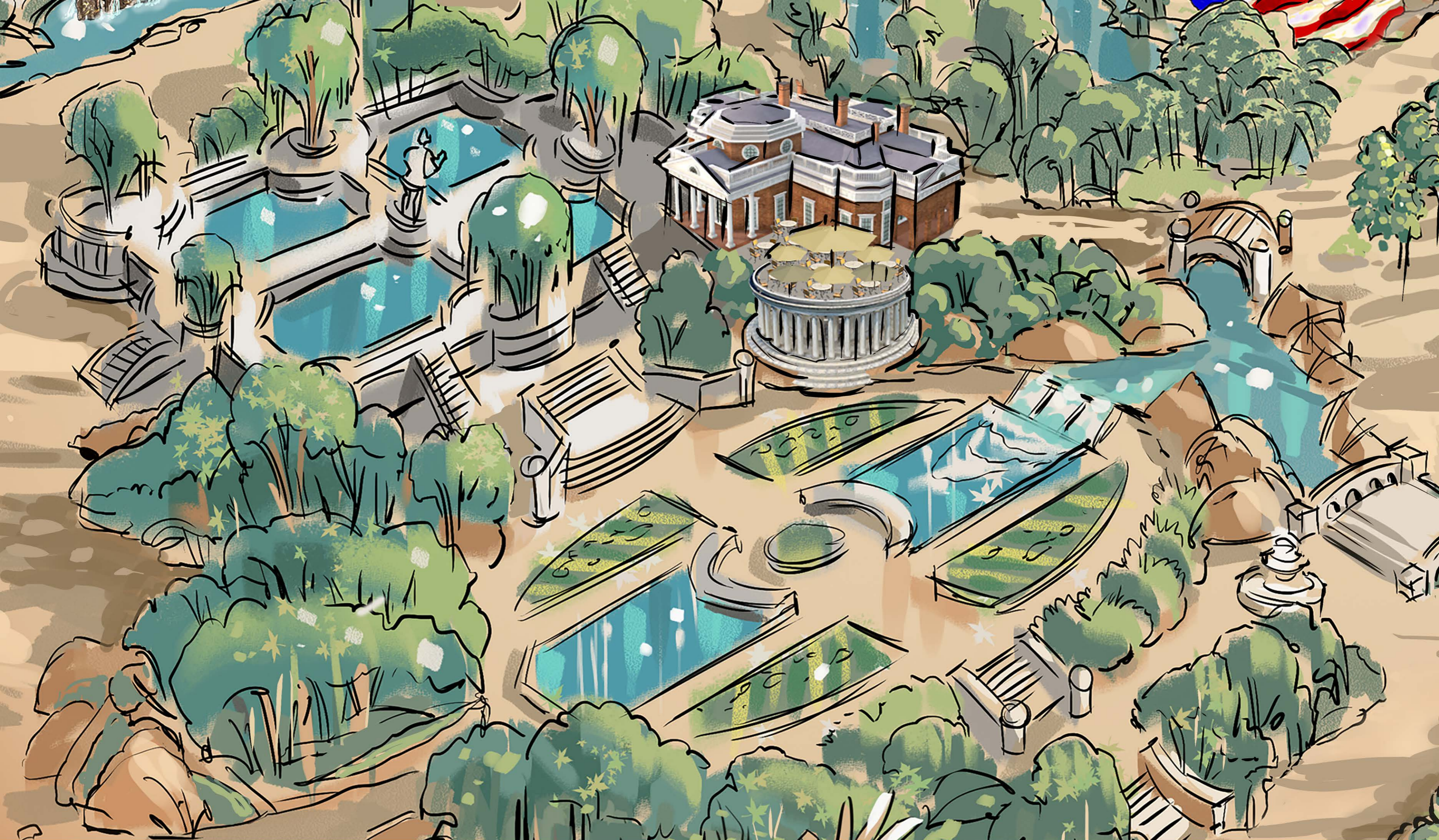

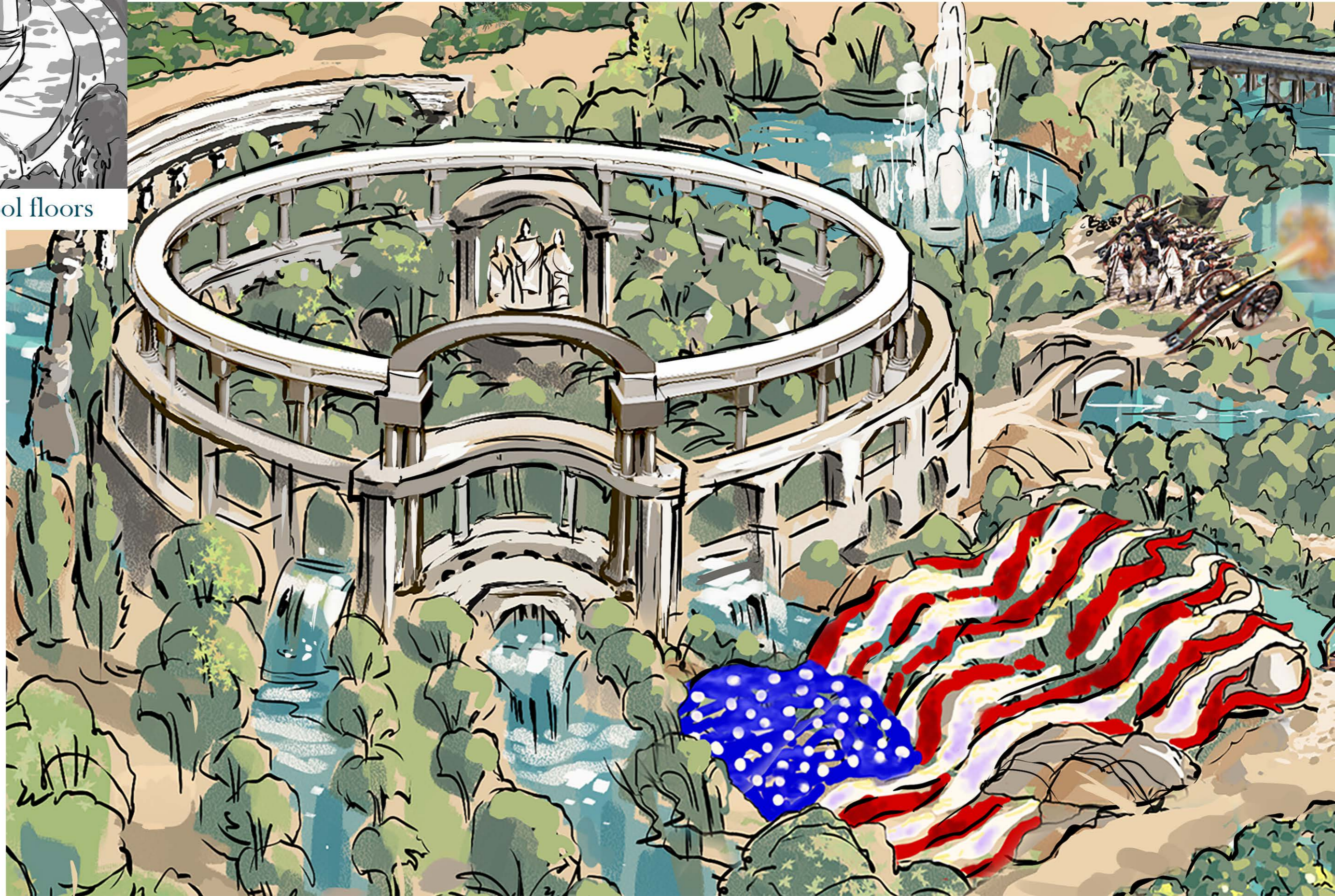

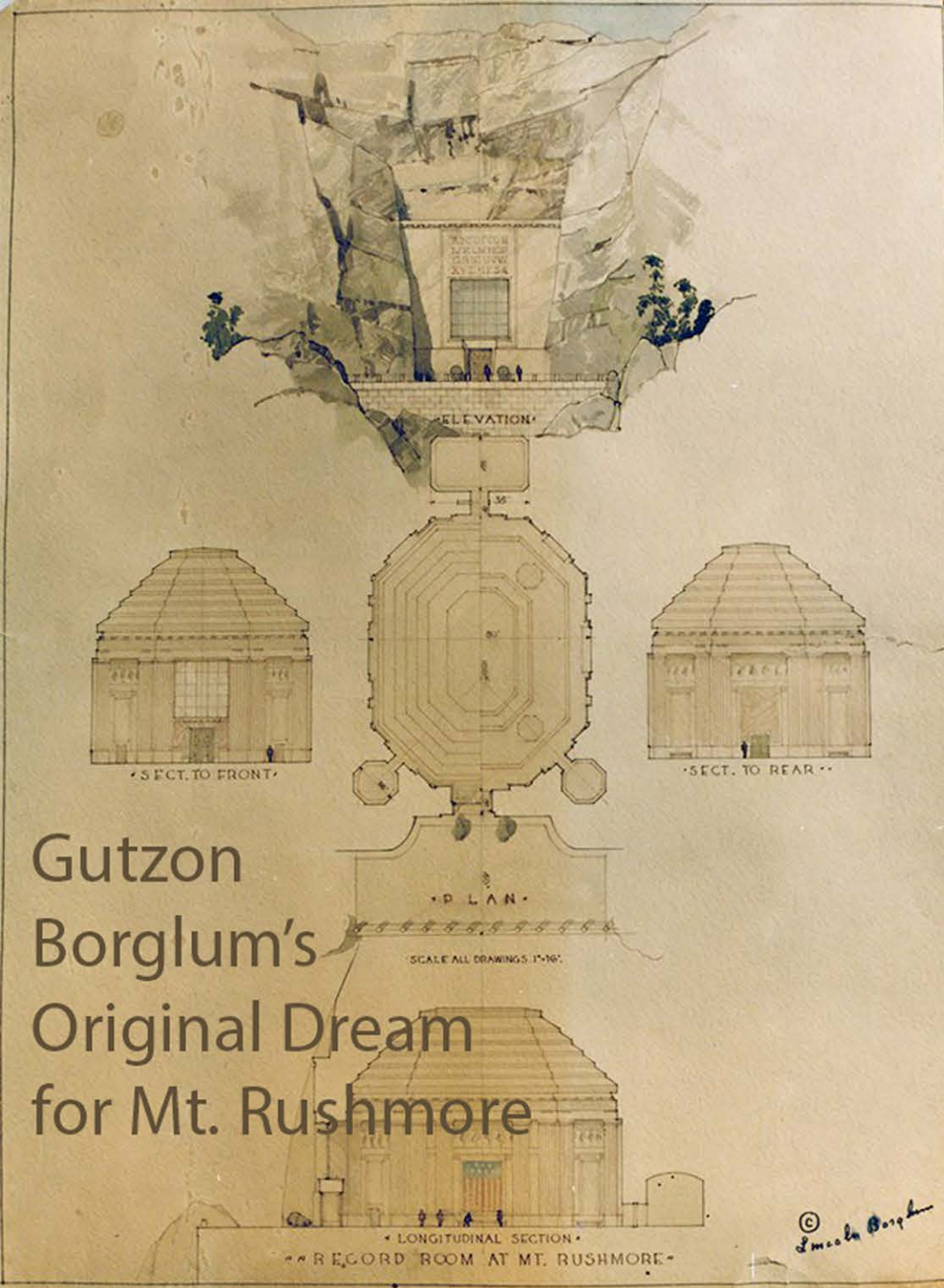

Gutzon Borglum, the Sculptor of Mt. Rushmore, made this drawing (left) of a large “Record Room” where he had hoped valuable original U.S. Documents might be safely stored. The excavation for it was started, but Borglum unfortunately died from surgery complications before it had progressed too far. It was dug-out enough so that today there is a crude smaller space carved out of the mountain, and even a locked door, behind which it is said various U.S. valuables have been locked away.



To the right is Borglum’s drawing (with added waterfall) integrated behind the proposed “Great Rock of Freedom”, at the center of The National Garden...

Borglum’s “Record Room” is thus fully realized as a beautifully carved grand vault where Visitors may enjoy various artistic tributes to American Heroes, many of which will have been previously displayed all around the country.

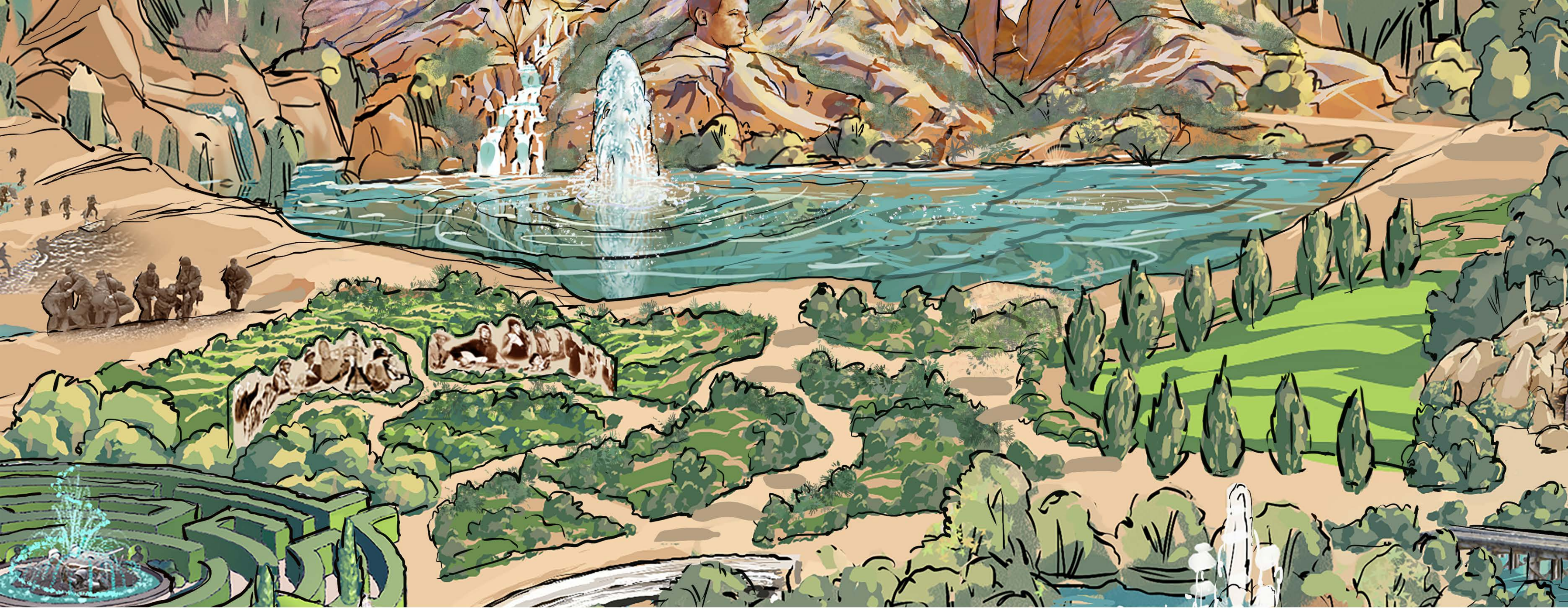

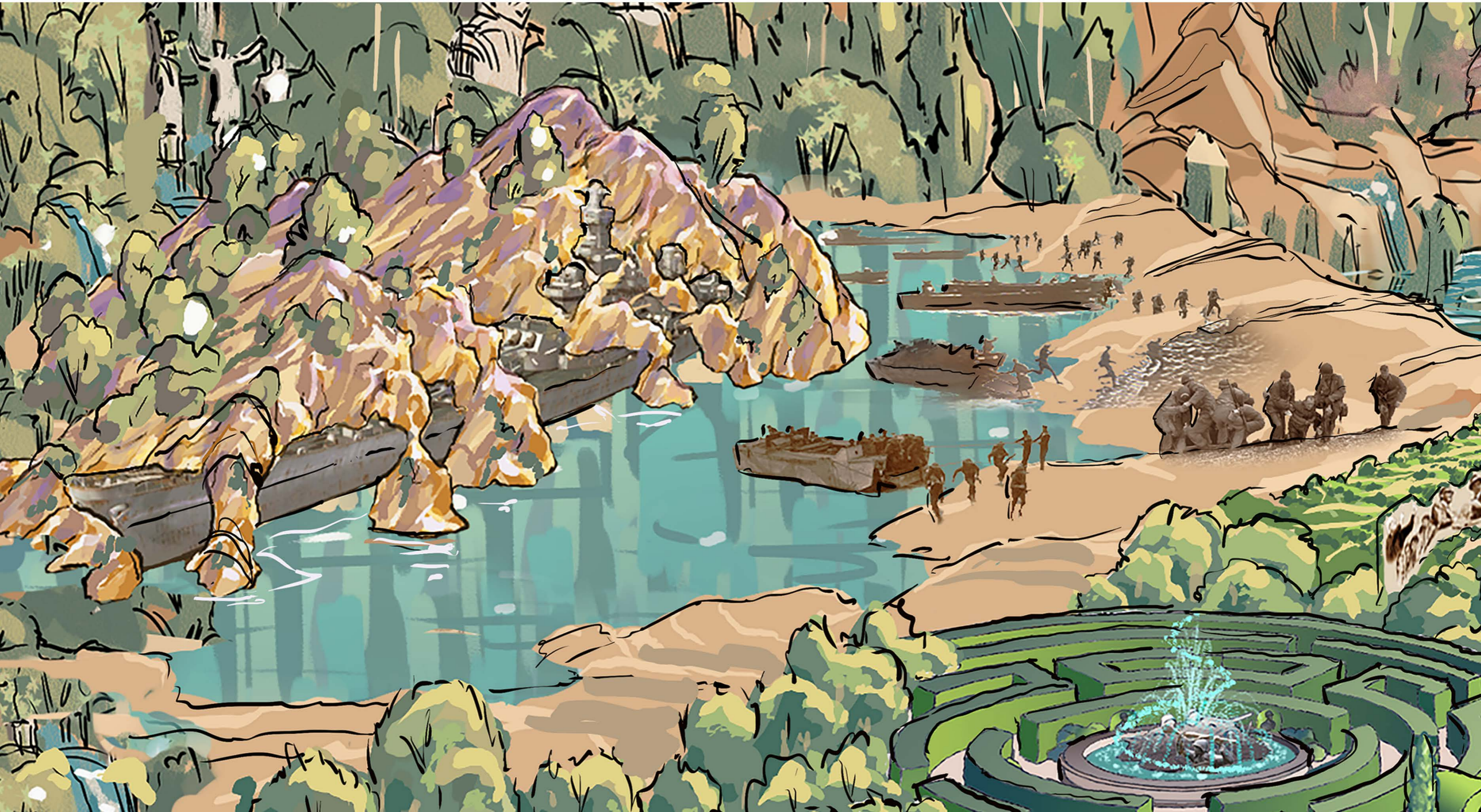

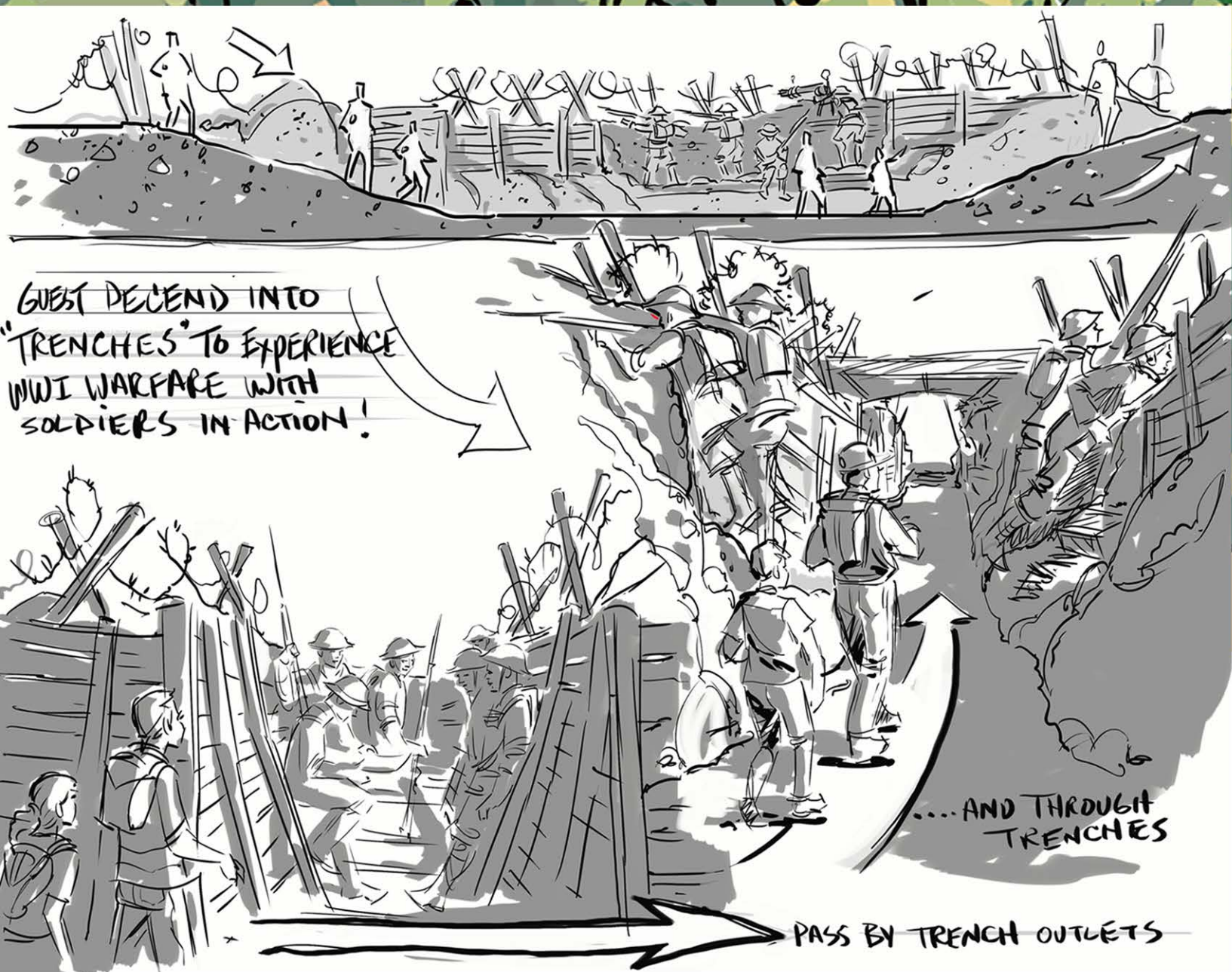
